The "Misteri" are an artistic representation of the Passion and Death of Jesus through twenty sculptural groups, including two statues of the Dead Jesus and of the Lady of Sorrows.

Event Title	THE LIQUEFACTION OF ST. JANUARIUS' BLOOD Januarius (Italian: San Gennaro), Bishop of Naples, is a Martyr saint of the Roman Catholic and the Eastern Orthodox Churches. Januarius is the patron saint of Naples, where the faithful gather three times a year in Naples Cathedral to witness the liquefaction of what is claimed to be a sample of his blood kept in a sealed glass ampoule. Saint Januarius is famous for the miracle of the annual liquefaction of his blood. Thousands of people assemble to witness this event in Naples Cathedral three times a year: on September 19 (Saint Januarius day, to commemorate his martyrdom), on December 16 (to celebrate his patronage of both Naples and of the archdiocese), and on the Saturday before the first Sunday of May (to commemorate the reunification of his relics).

	The Palio di Siena (known locally simply as Il Palio) is a horse race that is
	held twice each year, on July 2 and August 16, in Siena, Italy. Ten horses
	and riders, bareback and dressed in the appropriate colours, represent
	ten of the seventeen city wards (contrade, in Italian). The Palio held on
	July 2 is named Palio di Provenzano, in honour of the Madonna of
	Provenzano. The Palio held on August 16 is named Palio dell'Assunta, in
	honour of the Assumption of Mary.
	A pageant precedes the race, which attracts visitors and spectators from
	around the world.
	The race itself, in which the jockeys ride bareback, circles the Piazza del
	Campo, on which a thick layer of dirt has been laid, three times and
	usually lasts no more than 90 seconds. It is common for a few of the
